Traffic regulations

How to enter

Eligibility

The competition is open to women and men in age group 2003 and older.

Registration

You can register on the website of the ECSG Salzburg 2019. In order to register, you must accept the release from liability, and in so doing you also accept the competition terms and conditions and the rules of the event (announcement, rules and conditions of participation) as amended. Your spot in the race is only secured once the organiser has received your payment.

Registration ends at midnight on 24 June 2019.

Entry fees

The entry fee is EUR 18 when you register online.

Please take along your payment confirmation when you pick up your bib number, so that you can present proof of payment if necessary.

Included

All runners get to enjoy the atmosphere of a well-organised event, drinks along the course and at the finish, and timekeeping including race results.

Cancellations and transfers

Cancellations (no refund) and transfers are only possible in agreement with the office of the ECSG Salzburg 2019. You may be charged a EUR 5 processing fee.

Schedule

Saturday, 29 June 2019

- 10am–1pm: Bib number collection for all participants (not ECSG) at the Stiegl-Brauwelt
- 1.30pm: Start of both races in waves
- 1.50pm: Estimated finish time of 5km winner
- 2.10pm: Estimated finish time of 10km winner
- 2.20pm: 5km finish area closes
- 3pm: 10km finish area closes
- 3.30pm: Award ceremony
- 4pm: End of event

Timekeeping

Race times are recorded by the organiser's timekeeping system. Other timekeeping methods are inadmissible. The timekeeping chip must be worn during the race according to the organiser's specifications. If you do not wear the chip, your race time will not be recorded! The timekeeping chip is a running number transponder that is affixed to the back of your bib. You do not need to return the chip!

Refreshments

The organiser will provide two drinks stations:

- 5km and 10km race: Freibad Leopoldskron (at km 4.1)
- 10km race: Museum der Moderne (at km 7.4)

The drinks stations along the course and in the finish area offer water, Red Bull Energy Drink, Red Bull Cola, Stiegl Sportweisse and Melasan Sport isotonic drinks. Please dispose of your rubbish (wrappings, bottles, etc.) at the drinks stations only.

Parking

Participants can park in the parking lots of the Stiegl Brewery (Kreuzbrücklweg and Kendlerstrasse) and the ASKÖ sports centre (Eichetstrasse).

Bag drop

You can drop off a bag for storage during the race at both at the ASKÖ sports centre and at the Stiegl-Brauwelt. Please note, however, that these areas are not guarded, and the organiser accepts no liability for deposited belongings.

Toilets

The toilets at the ASKÖ sports centre and Stiegl-Brauwelt can be used. There are no toilets along the course.

The showers and changing rooms at the ASKÖ sports centre can be used. Signposts show how to get from the ASKÖ sports centre to the Stiegl-Brauwelt and back.

Medical assistance

The organiser will provide sufficient first aid stations along the entire course. In case of an emergency, call 144 and refer to the event.
